Autumn Term	Topic Under the Sea	Brief description Pupils will be researching Artists whose work is informed by the sea/ nature. Observational drawings focus shells, coral and pebbles. Pupils will be using a range of 2D and 3D process. They will experiment with different materials, techniques and will have the opportunity to develop their work into clay and felting.

Summer Term	Topic Sweets and Cakes	Brief description Pupils will be researching Artists whose work is informed by the confectionary and Still Life. Observational drawings focus sweets and cakes. Pupils will be using a range of 2D and 3D process. They will experiment with different materials, techniques and will have the opportunity to develop their work into paint and felting.

Autumn Term	Topic Sweets and Cakes	Brief description See above
Spring Term	Topic External Exam	Brief description From January the 1 st the External Examination paper is given out to candidates, whereby they select <u>one</u> question. Pupils are given unlimited time to prepare drawings, take photos, collect research and produce design ideas for this “externally set task”. They will then have ten hours to complete a final piece in supervised examination conditions. This is worth 40% of the overall grade.
